**Congress Government abandoned
Balasaheb Thakre's S. R. A. Scheme: Subhash Desai**

Mumbai, Tuesday: "The slum dwellers of Mumbai will definitely teach the Congress Govt. a lesson for winding up the S. R. A. Scheme which was to house **40 lakh** slum dwellers so far", said Shri Subhash Desai, a senior leader of the Shiv Sena.
