Hemendra Mehta creates chaos in presence of Ram Naik & Sanjay Nirupam

Mumbai, Wednesday: Shri Hemendra Mehta, former M.L.A. & NCP leader today created chaos in the meeting in which all prominent members viz. Shri Ram Naik, Shri Sanjay Nirupam and Shri Shirish Parkar were present.

Inspired Bharat Action Forum and 24 other organizations had jointly convened a meeting at G H High School, Borivli in which all contestants of Mumbai North parliamentary constituency were invited. Shri Hemendra Mehta who was previously M.L.A. from Borivli created chaos and the organizers were forced to dissolve the meeting. **Inspired Bharat Action Forum** had convened this meeting to give an opportunity to voters to know their candidates. The agenda of the meeting was that the moderators would welcome all, thereafter all the candidates would present their manifesto and later they would comment on the demands put up earlier to them and before the review of minutes & vote of thanks citizens who had submitted their questions in writing would be given a chance to voice the same. Accordingly, in the beginning Shri Dattaram Kosambe, President of the Forum welcomed all; thereafter the three candidates viz. Shri Ram Naik of BJP, Shri Sanjay Nirupam of Congress and Shri Shirish Parkar of MNS talked about their manifesto and reacted on charter of demands. When voters were to start asking their questions Shri Hemendra Mehta suddenly rose and started asking questions in a disturbing manner. Shri Kosambe stopped Shri Mehta as he was breaking code of conduct of the meeting. This annoyed Shri Mehta and he started shouting and accusing and few others joined him and created chaos. However, the president was firm on his stand. The organizers opined that the scene was a mockery of democracy and therefore they dissolved the meeting.

The voters were anguished as they lost a good opportunity to know their candidates. Their anger was obvious.
