

Ram Naik confident of the victory while ending campaigning

Mumbai, Monday : Shri Ram Naik, BJP-Shivsena candidate of Mumbai North today completed last round of his campaigning atop his 'Parivartan Rath'. Shri Naik was confident of the victory while winding up the campaign.

"Give me your one day (i.e. day of polling) and I shall give you five years" was the concluding appeal made by Shri Naik. His campaigning began on 27th March i.e. Gudhi Padwa-first day of Hindu New Year day and completed it on 27th April on Akshaytritiya. North Mumbai constituency consists of 38 municipal wards.
